According to this recall notice on the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's website, some Wranglers and gladiators equipped with a manual gearbox option may have their clutch pressure plate overheating and fracture. The resulting debris can be ignited with ignition or fuel lines, which increases the risk of fire. The recall notice says the issue potentially affected up to 33,237 vehicles scattered around Wranglers, built in 2018-2020, and Gladiators built in 2020. Jeep has yet to develop a fix, but NHTSA says the recall is expected to begin April 22, 2020. If you think your jeep may be affected by the recall, head over to the NHTSA website and enter the VIN.
